

INTRAVASCULAR CONTRAST MEDIA POLICY

All administrations of intravascular contrast material should be directed by a radiologist or other appropriately trained physician throughout the procedure.

A physician must be immediately available to respond promptly and furnish assistance and direction to an adverse event and should have appropriate training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and management related to intravascular contrast material administration.

This does **not** mean that the physician must be present in the room where and when the procedure is performed.

I understand and will abide this directive for IV contrast media administration. I further understand that I should contact my Premier Medical Texas supervisor in the event I should ever be requested to perform an exam in violation of this policy.
